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## MANUAL FOR FILLING UP THE BARANGAY PROFILE QUESTIONNAIRE January 2007

### **Barangay Data Enumeration Forms and Procedures**

The Barangay Profile Questionnaire (CBMS Form 2) is designed to gather supplementary information to the Household Profile Questionnaire (CBMS Form 1).

The questionnaire is composed of eight pages including the cover page. The first two pages contain questions pertaining to the physical and demographic characteristics of the barangay. The second part of the questionnaire consists of questions concerning the availability/accessibility of basic services provided, location of institutions, and other basic facilities in the barangay. The third section gathers information on the different types of crimes reported in the barangay. The fourth section gathers information on calamities that affected the barangay. The last portion focuses on tourism facilities present in the barangay.

## Procedures in Filling-up the Barangay Profile Questionnaire

### Identification

The first thing that the enumerator should do is to fill-up the information identifying the respondent, position in the barangay and the date when the questionnaire was accomplished. Enter the time the interview started. Indicate am if the survey started in the morning or pm if in the afternoon.

The respondent for this questionnaire should be the Barangay Captain or Barangay Secretary of the barangay.

### I. PHYSICAL AND DEMOGRAPHIC CHARACTERISTICS

Write the name of the province, municipality/city and the barangay to identify the place being surveyed. Indicate the Philippine Standard Geographic Code (PSGC) of the province, city/municipality and barangay. This will help in identifying the barangay. These codes can be found in Appendix 1. Write the classification of the barangay as well as the number of puroks and sitios found in the barangay.

## II. PROXIMITY OF BARANGAY LOCATION TO BASIC SERVICES AND SERVICE INSTITUTIONS

### Road network

Roads may be in the form of the following: concrete, asphalt, gravel, and natural/earth surface. Question 28 pertains to the length (in kilometers) of the road/street. Question 29 pertains to the present condition of the road/street (code 1-good, 2-fair, and 3-poor). Question 30 asks who is maintaining the road/street (1-private, 2-national, 3-provincial, 4-municipal, 5-barangay- and 6-others, specify).

If there is no concrete road or street in the barangay, determine the distance (in kilometers) of the nearest concrete road or street from the barangay (Question 31). Likewise, if there is no asphalt road in the barangay determine the distance (in kilometers) of the nearest asphalt road or street from the barangay (Question 32).

### Garbage/Waste Disposal System

Determine the presence of a community garbage disposal facility in the barangay (question 39). The garbage disposal system can be done by open dumping, sanitary landfill, use of incinerators or other method of disposal.

- Open dumpsite – garbage is thrown in open pits and left to decay in an open area, usually in a vacant land.
- Sanitary landfill – waste is buried between layers of earth to build up low-lying land.
- Incinerators – device like a furnace that is used to burn the garbage into ashes in an enclosed area.
- Compost pits – garbage thrown in uncovered dug pits and allowed to decay under controlled conditions.
- Others – other garbage disposal facility not classified above. Specify it in the questionnaire.

Check the appropriate box in the column for question 40. If the facility is present in the barangay, enter the number of households being served by each facility (question 41). If there is no disposal facility in the barangay, determine the distance to the nearest garbage disposal facility from the barangay (question 42).

### Credit institutions and Organizations

Write the number of credit institutions present in the barangay in the space provided for question 48. A credit institution can be a private moneylender, pawnshop, cooperative, non-government organization or a government institution from where the people in the barangay can obtain a loan. Enumerate the name of the organization (question 49) and the contact person in the organization (question 50).

### III. PEACE AND ORDER

Indicate the reported cases of crimes in the barangay. Crime is an act or offense from a public law which makes the offender liable to punishment to that law. It is classified into four types (against persons, property, and other crimes).

- i. Crime against persons – examples are murder, homicide, physical injury, rape etc.
- ii. Crime against property – examples are robbery, theft and other similar cases.
- iii. Domestic violence
  - a. 18 years and above – refers to any physical, emotional, psychological, sexual, economic assault/abuse against spouse, domestic helper, and other households members who are 18 years old and above.
  - b. child abuse (below 18 years old) – refers to any physical, emotional, psychological, sexual, economic assault/abuse against children who are below 18 years of age.
- iv. Other crimes
  - a. Drug trafficking – refers to the prohibited trade of addictive drugs.
  - b. Drug using – refers to the prohibited possession and usage of addictive drugs.
  - c. Prostitution – refers to the act or practice of indulging in promiscuous sexual relations especially for money.
  - d. Alcohol-related case – crimes committed under the influence of excessive drunkenness.
  - e. Others – other crimes not classified above. Specify it in the space provided.

Enter the number of **reported cases** for each crime reported during the past 12 months at the appropriate space in Column 51. Disaggregate the victims of crimes by sex. Indicate the number of solved cases in column 52 also disaggregating the data by sex.

Question 53 specifically asked for reported crimes that involves tourists. Indicate in questions 54 and 55 the number of cases that were reported and solved for both the tourist being the perpetrator and the victim of crime.

**V. TOURISM FACILITIES**

This section focuses on the tourism facilities found in the barangay.

**Accommodation Establishments**

Questions 60-63 is about the accommodation establishments found in the barangay. The types of establishments are as follows:

1. Hotel – a building, edifice or premises or a completely independent part thereof, which is used for the regular reception, accommodation or lodging of travelers and tourists and the provision of services incidental thereto for a fee.
2. Resort – any place or places with pleasant environment and atmosphere conducive to comfort, healthful relaxation and rest, offering food, sleeping accommodation and recreational facilities to the public for a fee or remuneration.
3. Pension House – a private or family-operated tourist boarding house, tourist guest house or tourist lodging house employing non-professional domestic helpers regularly catering to tourists and travelers, containing several independent lettable rooms, providing common facilities such as toilets, bathrooms/showers, living and dining rooms and/or kitchen and where a combination of board and lodging may be provided.
4. Youth hostel/Dormitory - a private or family-operated tourist boarding house that caters mostly to students.
5. Apartel/Rented home/Apartment – any building or edifice containing several independent and furnished or semi-furnished apartments, regularly leased to tourists and travelers for dwelling on a more or less long term basis and offering basic services to its tenants, similar to hotels.

### Travel Agencies / Tour Operators

Questions 64 to 66 details the travel agencies or tour operators that are present in the barangay.

A **tour operator** shall mean an entity which may either be a single proprietorship or corporation, regularly engaged in the business of extending to individuals or groups, such services pertaining to arrangements and bookings for transportation and/or accommodation, handling and/or conduct of inbound tours whether or not for a fee, commission, or any form of compensation. On the other hand, a **tour guide** shall mean an individual who guides tourists, both foreign and domestic, for a fee, commission, or any other form of lawful remuneration.

The type of travel agency/tour operator are are follows:

1. Inbound tour – means a tour to or of the Philippines or any place within the Philippines
2. Outbound tour – means a tour to any place outside the Philippines
3. Combination – a tour which is inbound and outbound; within and outside the Philippines.

A **tourist transport operator** is a person or entity which may either be a single proprietorship, partnership or corporation, regularly engaged in providing, for a fee or lawful consideration, tourist transport services. They can be by land or by water transport, the difference of which lies in the type of vehicle/craft used. Examples of land transport includes tour bus, van, car while water transport crafts include passenger ship, ferry, pleasure yacht and other similar conveyances.

If the 8-paged questionnaire is already accomplished, go back to the cover page and write the time the interview ended.

### VII. BARANGAY SPOT MAP

**At the bottom portion of page 1 of the questionnaire notes that a duly accomplished spotmap of the barangay should be attached to the 8-paged questionnaire before submission to the supervisor.**

A spot map is like a picture of an area taken from the top view perspective. Specify the boundaries in the barangay. Natural boundaries such as creeks, rivers, waterfalls and other water tributaries, caves, and historical landmarks should be clearly specified. The manmade infrastructures such as road networks, bridges and railroads should also be indicated in the spot map.

Visible building establishments such as houses, barangay halls, multipurpose halls, gymnasium/stadium, sports complex, basketball/ volleyball/ pelota/ tennis courts, swimming pools, library/reading centers, cockpit, barangay outposts, elementary and secondary schools,

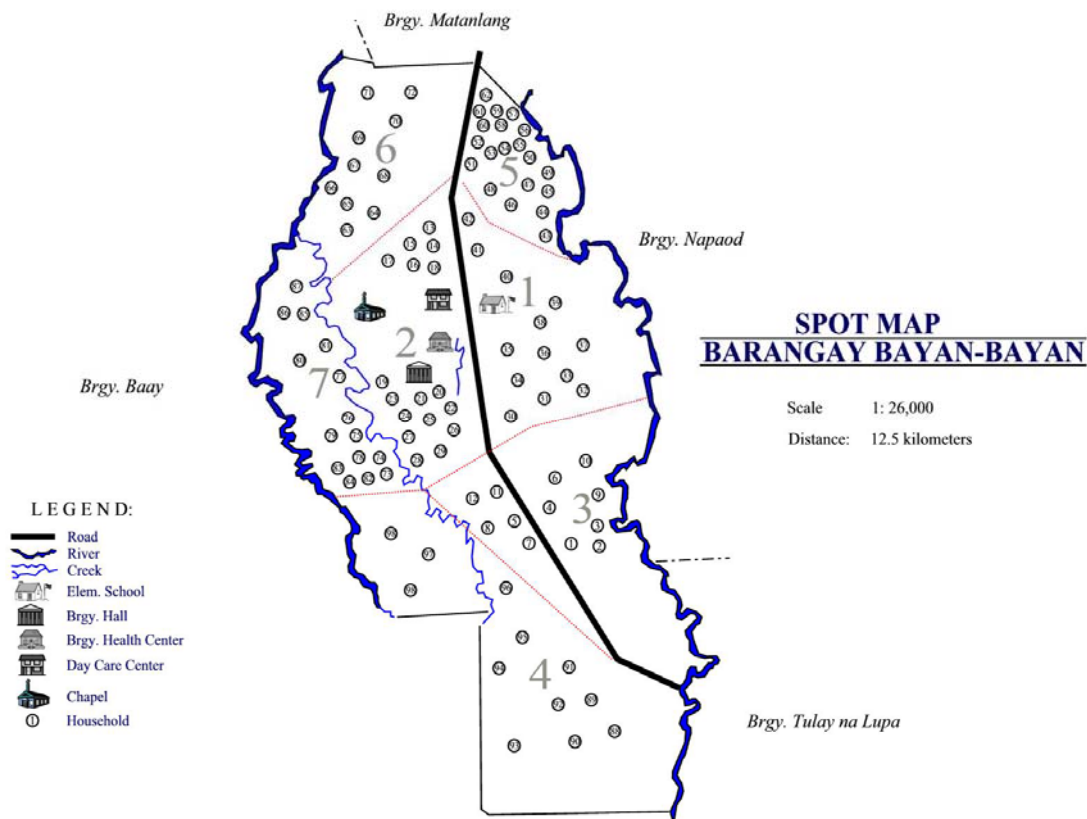
colleges/university, hospitals/clinics, day care centers, banks, markets, restaurants, and other buildings existing in the barangay should be clearly indicated in the spot map. Other sites such as for garbage disposal like open dump site, sanitary landfill and incineration plants should also be marked in the spot map.

Please note that the location of each household should be clearly marked in the map. The spot map will be used to locate specific household during the conduct of the survey.

**Steps in creating a barangay spotmap**

1. Draw the natural boundaries such as bodies of water (river, creeks, waterfalls, etc.), caves, hills, etc. Include also historical landmarks.
2. Draw the road networks in the barangay. Indicate the type of road whether concrete, asphalt or natural/earth surface. Also include railroads and bridges if they are present in the barangay.
3. Delineate the purok boundaries. Usually, if there are natural boundaries and a road network, delineation of puroks follow the same trail.
4. When all the necessary landmarks are in placed, indicate the location of building establishments such as houses, barangay halls, multipurpose halls, gymnasium/stadium, sports complex, basketball/volleyball/ pelota/ tennis courts, swimming pools, library/ reading centers, cockpit, barangay outposts, elementary and secondary schools, colleges/ university, hospitals/clinics, day care centers, banks, markets, restaurants, and other buildings existing in the barangay.
5. Other sites such as for garbage disposal like open dump site, sanitary landfill and incineration plants should also be marked in the spot map.
6. Indicate the location of all households in the barangays. Each household should have a unique household number. This household ID number will be used to locate the households during the survey period.
7. Indicate a legend to identify what are included in the spotmap.
